COLORADO SYMPHONY ANNOUNCES BEETHOVEN AND BREWS AT BLUE MOON BREWING COMPANY – RINO

Beethoven's Symphony No. 1 will be performed by the Colorado Symphony's full orchestra on March 7

Jan. 22, 2018 – Denver, CO – The Colorado Symphony announces the next installment in their Beethoven and Brews series with a performance of Beethoven's Symphony No. 1 at Blue Moon Brewing Company – RiNo. The event will take place on Wednesday, March 7, 2018 beginning at 6:30 p.m.

If not sold out, general admission tickets will be available at the door for \$65 beginning at 6:00 p.m. Standard ticket prices are \$65 while VIP tickets are \$85.
