COLORADO SYMPHONY ANNOUNCES TWO PERFORMANCES AT MCGREGOR SQUARE

Enjoy Mozart under the stars on July 10 and an evening of Classical and Pops favorites on September 4

Apr. 11, 2024 – Denver, CO – The Colorado Symphony is thrilled to announce its return to one of Denver's newest entertainment destinations, McGregor Square, for two performances this summer.



The first performance will take place on July 10 and will feature Associate Conductor Wilbur Lin leading a Colorado Symphony ensemble in an evening of Mozart under the stars.

The second performance will feature Resident Conductor Christopher Dragon leading the full Colorado Symphony Brass and Percussion in a diverse and engaging performance featuring Classical and Pops favorites on September 4.

Situated in the heart of Denver's historic Lower Downtown (LoDo) district, McGregor Square has become a hub for cultural events and entertainment since opening in 2021. Having rapidly established itself as a premier venue for cultural events, entertainment, and community engagement, the square's unique blend of modern design and urban charm provides the perfect backdrop for the symphony's enchanting melodies.
