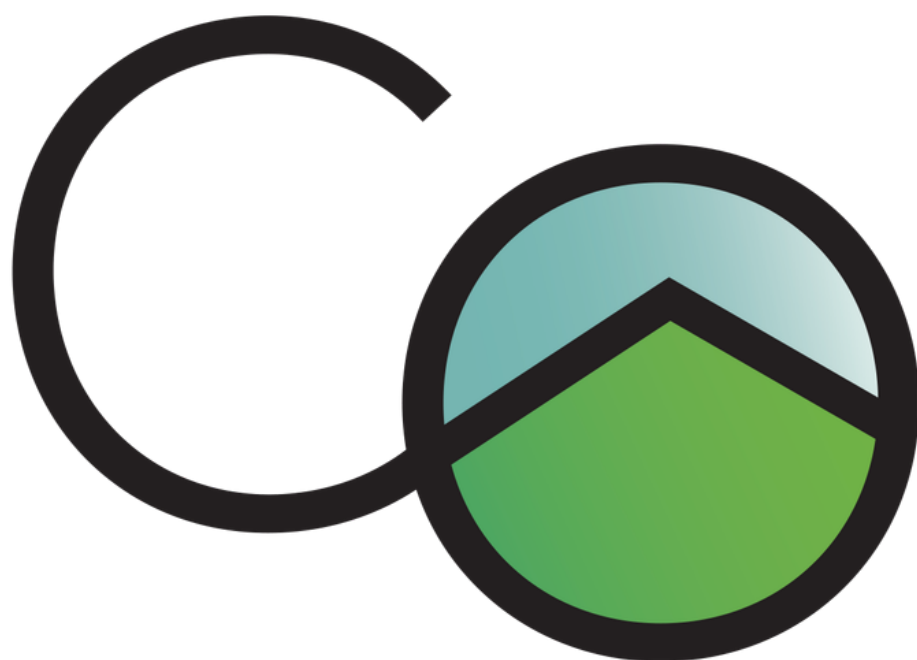

Logistics & Expectations: Before the Concert

ARRIVING

- We recommend arriving 30 minutes early to allow extra time for traffic and drop-off. **Text: 719-508-3374 with your name and school if you are running late. **
 - **BUS DROP-OFF**
 - Drop-Off will be located at Sculpture Park
 - Please see map for bus route on how to access drop-off location
 - Buses will remain parked at Sculpture Park as space permits
 - Once space has reached capacity, buses will need to park at Ball Arena
 - ****For schools staying post-concert to eat at Sculpture Park, those buses must park at Ball Arena to help with post-concert traffic flow.**
 - ****Be sure to exchange contact information with your bus driver.**
- A member of the Colorado Symphony Team will greet you and escort your class into the concert hall OR to a flag to await your time to enter the hall.
- Please note that you may have to wait to enter the concert hall. We will do our best to get you seated as quickly as possible. Please be patient.

LUNCHES

- A member of our usher team will assist in finding a location in the lobby to store your lunches.

INCLEMENT WEATHER NOTE

If inclement weather results in performance cancellation, we will notify the individual listed on your reservation form via e-mail and phone as soon as possible.

To help our team prepare for your arrival, please print off and display one sign for **EACH** bus with your school name and how many buses you have coming.

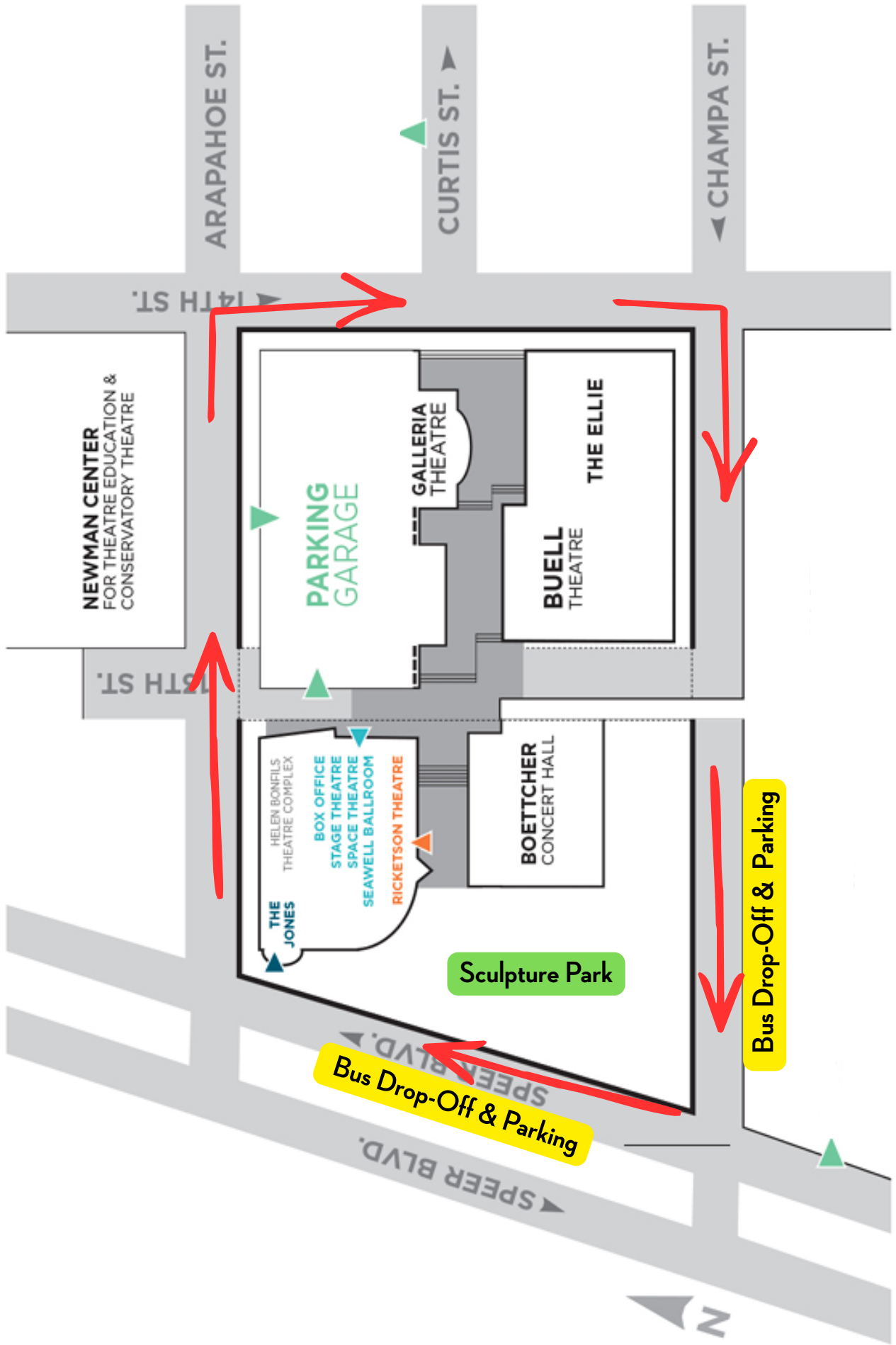

All pick-ups will be located at Sculpture Park

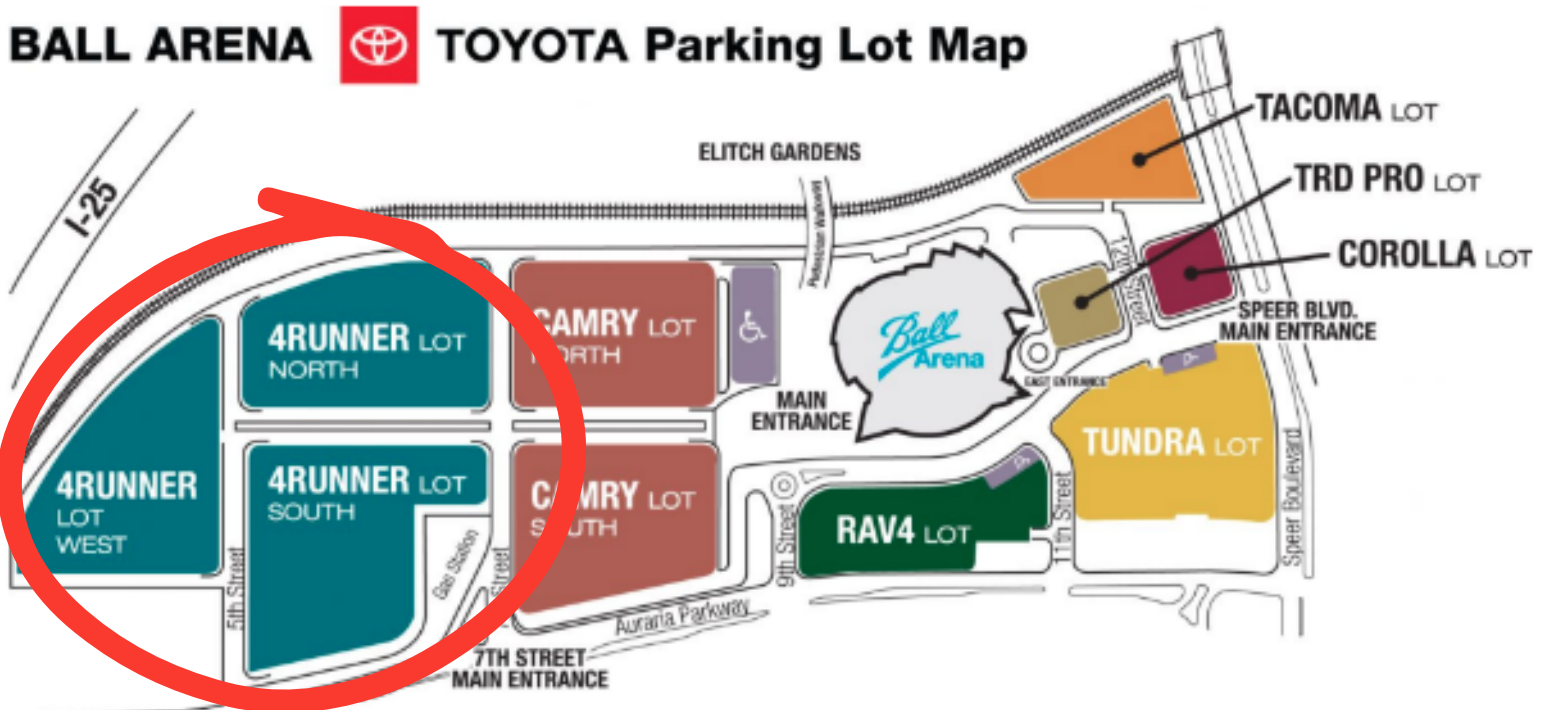


Ball Arena Parking

Ball Arena Parking is for the following:

- Schools staying for lunch
- Overflow parking for performance

Bus drivers will need to park in the 4Runner Lot located off Auraria Parkway and 7th Street. You may also access this lot from Speer Blvd. by turning left on Chopper Circle





Logistics & Expectations: During the Concert

- Once your group is seated in the hall, students who need to use the bathroom must be escorted by a chaperone.
- Our concerts are engaging and often allow for audience involvement. Please know that we are happy to have students use their voices. clap and cheer in an appropriate way.

- Flash photography is strictly prohibited
- Videos must remain under 60 seconds

Logistics & Expectations: After The Concert

- Schools will be dismissed one at a time from the stage.
- Exit Boettcher Concert Hall towards Sculpture Park where you will be picked up by your buses.
- If your group is eating lunch post-concert, you may do so at Sculpture Park.
 - Unfortunately, due to City of Denver restrictions, we are not allowed to have groups eat lunch inside the hall. Covered areas are available in the DPAC galleria area.
